The NCCC Convention will be held in the home of the Corvette, Bowling Green, KY on June 25th through June 30th. Plans include some interesting tours and parties, the usual assortment of competitive events, and a celebration of the 70th birthday of the Corvette. Mark your calendar now and look for more information as it becomes available. Registration will open on February 1st.

Here are a couple clubs celebrating major milestones this year: Perry County Corvette Club is celebrating 45 years and Midwest Early Corvette Club is celebrating 50 years. Congratulations to both.

The September NCCC Governors meeting is just around the corner (September 9th and 10th). In addition to regular business, we will hear from each of the candidates running for National office. This year five offices will be up for election. They are: President, Vice President of Membership, Treasurer, Parliamentarian, and Director of Public Relations. Have you heard about all the exciting improvements and changes at the National Corvette Museum? Driven by Design, a 6,500-square-foot exhibit focused on the history of Corvette's design process and the stories of the diverse group of individuals responsible for the most iconic sports car design of all time will be opening soon. Also, as you probably know, the Motorsports Park sustained some major damage last December when an EF-3

tornado touched down. Rebuilding plans now include a 2.4 million dollar budget to make major improvements including much-needed indoor and outdoor event spaces, bar and restaurant offerings in the track observation areas, and upgraded garage facilities.
